On Monday 5th Feb, we attended school with bags of coppers (1ps & 2ps). With this, we counted how many of each coin we had and multiplied it by its diameter. Each class member calculated the length of the money they brought in which was then added to the rest of their table's which was then finally added to every tables' total, thus finally resulting in our grand total.
