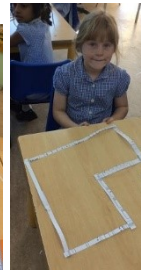
Year 2 getting active with Southend Sports Partnership



Year 6 enjoyed sorting shapes practically. They sorted them in all different ways - colour, size, number of sides, quadrilaterals, polygons, regular and irregular.

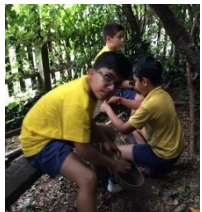

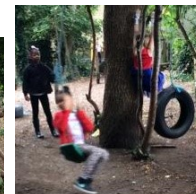
