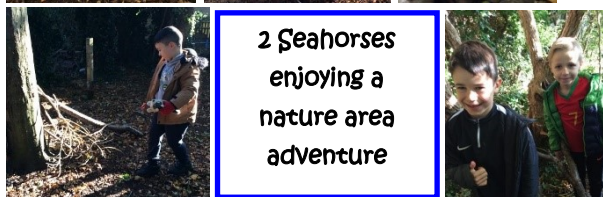

books and money!

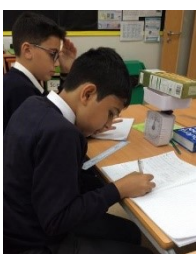
Nature Area Sign Competition
