COVID UPDATE

Earlier this week, the Government announced the details of their Living with Covid plan. These are the main points which affect our school community:

TESTING - The Government have removed the guidance for twice weekly asymptomatic testing.

SELF ISOLATION - The Government have removed the <u>legal</u> requirement to self-isolate following a positive test.

But they still advise that anyone who tests positive should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for at least 5 full days. To also continue with the current guidance of staying at home until they receive 2 negative tests on 2 consecutive days. CLOSE CONTACTS - The Government will no longer ask fully vaccinated close contacts and those under 18, to test for 7 days. They have also removed the legal requirement for close contacts who are not fully vaccinated to self-isolate.

Close contacts should continue to attend school as usual.

The Queen's Platinum Jubilee Celebrations.


Our school has signed up for the project "School Superbloom."




