Write an information text containing important facts about either:

- the ancient Aztec civilisation
- the various Native American tribes

Include plenty of images.

Make a word search including as many states of the USA as you can manage! Challenge a friend or family member to find them!

Find out about an animal native to North America and create a poster with information about it.

Listen to the national anthems of a few North American countries. Can you learn the words and melody of one song and perform it?

Carefully research, design and recreate an object representing an aspect of Native American culture, using materials of your choice. Ideas include: a dream catcher, totem pole, tepee, moccasin, corn husk doll, Hopi Kachina doll, headdress/war bonnet, a piece of beadwork jewellery, an accurate copy of a Navajo pattern (could be done on maths paper). Write a paragraph about your chosen item, from its history and use to what it was made of. Include why you chose it and how you made it.



Did you know French is spoken in parts of Canada and the Caribbean? Using all the phrases you have learned, can you write a short note to an imaginary pen-pal living there; tell them a little about yourself.

Research some North American dishes and recipes, such as hamburgers, apple pie or tacos. Choose something to cook with a responsible adult and take photos of you enjoying the food together!

Find out about American Football. Compare it with English football (soccer). Present your findings in an interesting way,

Research the famous American 'pop artist' Andy Warhol. Create your own piece of pop art. Place this in your book or bring your artwork to school. Write a short paragraph about what you like/dislike about this style of art.
