Jesus Light of the World, you promised to be always with us.

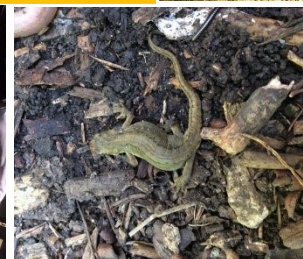
We pray for the people of the Ukraine, for all those suffering and afraid, that you will be close to them and protect them.
