

### Literacy

We will be continuing to develop our handwriting and presentation skills across all subjects. We will be learning to write poetry. TFW will be used to encourage children to recognise features of a text with the aim of the children incorporating these features in their writing.

Spelling and grammar: we will be revising our spelling rules and looking at homophones - sea-see, right-write etc

#### Ways to help at home

- Listen to your child read daily and ask them questions about the text.

### RE

## Food glorious food!

### Mathematics

We will be learning to use our number fact knowledge to help us in other areas of maths we will be learning how to use what we know to help us learn something new.

We will revisit measurement and ensure children can use their number skills to solve word problems.

#### Ways to help at home:

Reinforce child's learning by using mathematical vocabulary at home. Practise the time at home. Help them to understand the fifteen-minute intervals quarter past and quarter to. Remember to practise the 2, 5, and 10 times tables for Bronze award and the 3 and 4 times table for silver.

### Topic

Our topic will incorporate design technology, science and geography.

#### We will be learning about:

### Healthy Bodies

The children will be learning about bones and muscles and looking in detail at their heart.
