

English:

First the children will be looking at instructions. We will look at how instructions are written using numbers and imperative verbs. Then the children will be writing instructions.

We will also be looking at poetry, particularly related to Christmas.

Ways to help at home:

Play games and look at the instructions that accompany them. Look at recipes, follow the instructions.

Read poetry and research poems using the internet. Try to make up silly rhyming sentences.

Geography: The children will be looking at cities in the uk. They will also be looking at where vegetables come from around the world and locating them on a map.

Music: The children will be looking at how to play a new instrument called the Sabre. We will also be learning Christmas songs for our performances.

Ways to help at home:

You could research and practise singing some traditional Christmas hymns as a family.

We will be locating cities in the UK and looking at how the land is used.

Ways to help at home
