Can you get creative? Research, design and make a Christmas card with a moving part. All entries can be posted into the post box in the hall.

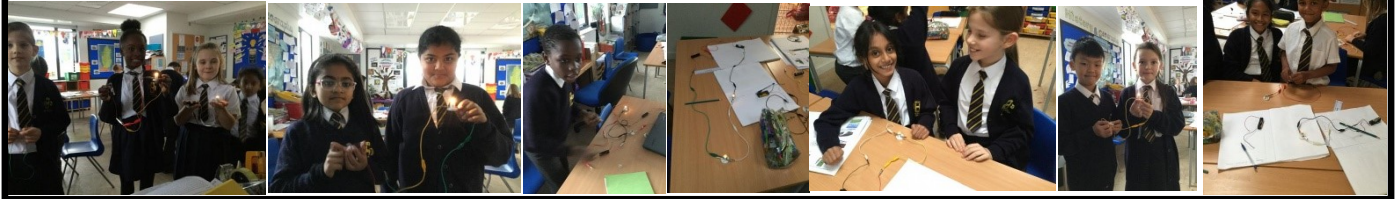
