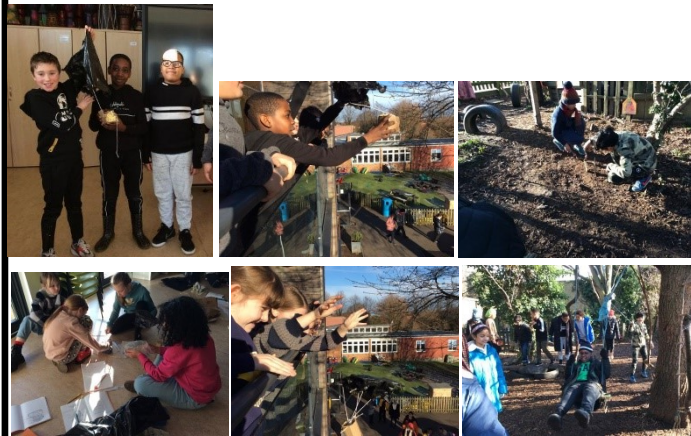
## Reception classes
