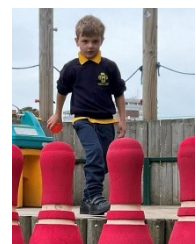

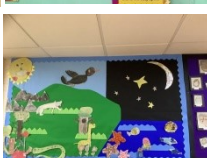
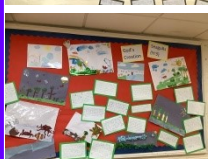


All of **year 5** had a zoom session with Farmer Carl from Intake farm in Yorkshire.

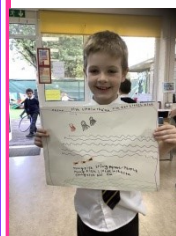
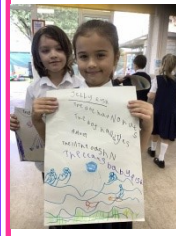
2 Seahorses spent an extremely windy afternoon in the nature area yesterday. As their Science topic is Living Things and Habitats, they decided to build habitats for some creatures. They undertook bug hunting and tree identification. They also enjoyed playing and eating popcorn.



The children are beginning their **RE** topic, answering the Big Questions and looking at the vocabulary for their topic. Work has started on their themes. Please see the RE section of this newsletter for the Bible story your child's class is studying.



2 Seahorses During provision, the children have been researching animals, what they eat and where they live. The children were challenged to complete a poster to share with their friends.



Year 5 experimented this afternoon. We mixed various solutes (solids) with a solvent (liquid) which was always water. We observed closely what happened when the solute and solvent mixed, commenting on what we found out.

We have left the solutions on the windowsill in the classroom to see what happens next. Some of us think the water will evaporate and it may leave some/all/none of the solute behind. The solutes were flour, baking powder, salt, sugar and sand.
