## English:

The children are looking at Greek Myths. They will look at a few different myths but mainly focus on Daedalus and Icarus for their Talk for Writing focus.

The children will also be writing play scripts using the same story and including the relevant features.

## Ways to help at home:

Complete the homework related to this on the homework web. Find examples of direct speech when reading as we will be learning how to write speech.

## Mathematics

Counting in thousands, partitioning 3d and 4d numbers, adding multiples of 1000 , learning 4 times table and related divisions. Learning simple fractions and symmetry

## Ways to help at home

Practise times tables in order, then out of order. Know the division and times family of facts for the 4 times table. Talk about whether things are symmetrical using the words horizontal, vertical and diagonal.

Geography: The children are recapping the continents from year two and they are looking at different hemispheres and time zones around the world.

## Ways to help at home: Talk

 about the above in relation to countries you have been to as a family or countries you would like to visit.Music: The children are learning a new song in which different groups of children sing in different parts. We then accompany this with the glockenspiel. Ways to help at home: Sing at home as a family. Find songs which involve different people singing different parts.

## Topic: It's all Greek to me
