English (writing)

Our model text is Keep Calm and go to Paris! Children are using this as a basis to write their own persuasive holiday brochures about a North American city. We will look at persuasive techniques like imperatives, rhetorical questions and boastful language. At home: Children must practise on Spelling Shed. **English (reading)** We will complete our whole class reading book, Viking Boy, and then begin Holes by Louis Sachar. Using our reading VIPERS, we follow the story of Stanley, who is sent to a Texas boot camp! At home: Read with your child daily.

North America

Topic

Geography: Studying the continent of North America, identifying its countries and capital cities; and investigating its climates and landscapes.

Art: Learning about the American artist Jackson Pollock and attempting to emulate his iconic style.
