The book of Joshua in the Old Testament tells the story of the city of Jericho and how the blowing of trumpets destroyed its walls. Read this story and make a cartoon booklet retelling the story in pictures or words.

Do you play an instrument? Can you dance? or maybe you could write and perform a rap song for the class with a friend?. In our last week of term we would like to put on a celebration for the class so if you want to perform now is your chance to start practicing.
