SCIENCE

Every half term, teachers and children add to their display regarding their Science topic. You can see how different the topics are and also work covered. Children learn new vocabulary and are challenged in their thinking by answering a big question which they re-visit at the end of the topic.



4G have been working on doubling and halving this week. The children worked in pairs to complete doubling and halving word problems. They then invented their own doubling and halving word problems and passed them to different pairs to complete.



3S completed their science unit on rock and fossils by making salt dough fossils! Some students made dinosaur footprints while others favoured a more traditional ammonite fossil shape.

Making SALT DOUGH is an easy and a fun half term activity! Mix 1 part table salt (say 200g) to 2 parts flour (say 400g). Then add 1 part water (200 ml) and knead to create dough. Store in a sealed plastic bag to keep fresh. Make any imprints using hands, toys, or use a cookie cutter to make a shape. Can be cooked on low heat to dry out or left at room
