

Topic: BRITAIN AT WAR

You must complete **5** of the homework options.
This project is to be handed in on **Monday 16th December**.



Find out about how animals were used during World War I and World War II. Create a leaflet or poster about this.

If planes and ships are your thing, why don't you find out about some that were used in World War I and World War II. Sketch them and write a description.

Design and create your own medal. Write an explanation of what your medal represents.

Create a scrapbook or diary as if you were a soldier during the war (WWI or WWII).

Create your own rationing menu; you could even make one of the dishes and take photographs or bring it in for others to try! (Don't forget to include the recipe and a list of ingredients.)

Discover what Christmas would be like during World War I.

- How would they celebrate?
- Would there be presents?
- What would they eat?

Think of your own questions to research.

Learn or create your own war song or poem and perform it to the class!

Find out and write about some of the famous faces from World War I and World War II (This could be a Power Point).

Create a model of a trench using any materials you like. Make it as detailed as you possibly can. Include labels if you wish.

Design your own set of decorative antiphons for use at Christmas time or design a stained glass window depicting scenes from the Nativity Or write a prayer for peace at Christmas time.
