Topic: BRITAIN AT WAR

You must complete 5 of the homework options. This project is to be handed in on Monday 16th December.

Find out about how animals were used during World War I and World War II. Create a leaflet or poster about this.

If planes and ships are your thing, why don't you find out about some that were used in World War I and World War II. Sketch them and write a description.

Design and create your own medal. Write an explanation of what your medal represents.

Create a scrapbook or diary as if you were a soldier during the war (WWI or WWII).

Discover what Christmas would be like during World War I.

- How would they celebrate?
- Would there be presents?
- What would they eat? Think of your own questions to research.
