Times Tables/ Learn Its:

Times Tables: 2s, 5s, 10s and counting in 3s.

Learn Its: $6+8=14$, $5+7=12$, $5+8=13$,
 $5+9=14$, $6+9=15$, $7+9=16$

Writing: This half term, we are writing fairy tales- with a twist!
