Please look at your CLIC tests each week, and practice the questions you are not confident on.

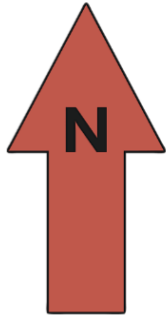
Make up some questions to practice mathematical methods!

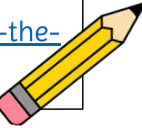
Practicing times tables:

Due by 13th July:

- *Ride design:* Design a new ride for Adventure Island! Draw or make a model of it and label its features.
- *Letter to a teacher:* Discuss with your grown ups how you feel about going into Year 4. Write a letter to your Year 4 teacher telling them how you feel, and what you are looking forward to next year.
