

RE Activities:

- Draw a person and add labels with the most important words/attributes showing how they follow God's rule.

-Think about a time when you have made the wrong choice. Make up a sorry prayer beginning: *Dear God I am sorry for...*

- Talk about forgiving - what do I need to do when someone has hurt me? Recall a time when this has happened to you, make a story board about it.

Creative art and design ideas:

- Put some fruit into a bowl and draw then colour what you can see. Look at the colours and patterns

- Create a collage called 'healthy body...healthy mind' – about the activities we do to keep our bodies and minds healthy? What would yours include? Books(reading), music notes(singing) skipping rope(keeping fit)...any of these?
