Thank you to all our families for following our new procedures at the beginning and end of the school day. Much appreciated!


Please note we have introduced a one-way system down the path— PLEASE KEEP TO THE LEFT.

If your child has a bike or scooter and goes into school through the front door or Yr 2 cage, please can you take them to the bike shed first and then to their point of entry. Thank you.




Year 6 enjoyed experimenting with balancing cans today.
