

Reading	<p>Read a book at home.</p> <p>Write a review of the book - would you recommend it, brief synopsis of story, why did you like, not like it?</p> <p>If you really, really liked it, create a poster persuading others to read it too.</p> <p>Read a wide variety of texts - comics, magazines, books and try some classics.</p>
Writing	<p>Spelling Shed - Year 6 slides 18-23 complete one a week and activities surrounding it. Complete look/cover/write/check with the spellings</p> <p>Write a diary - pretend you are Darkus from Beetle Boy. Write a diary that Darkus would keep for three days - think about meeting Uncle Max, moving into the house with him, friendship with Virginia and Bertolt, lastly starting to investigate his dad's disappearance.</p> <p>Write a letter from Darkus to the police asking for their help and saying what you have found out already. What is your/their plan?</p>
GPS	<p>Revise complex sentences. Then, look at relative clauses - another form of an embedded clause. Science	<p>Keep a food diary for the week and highlight food types/groups- protein, carbohydrates, fats, – which area are you eating more/less of, set your own target for the next week. For example - less fats - chocolate etc and more protein - fish. Re-do the food diary.</p> <p>How can we make healthy choices, discuss about freedom of choice in Year 7- look up on your new school's website what kind of food they offer in the canteen. Think about what you would choose and why?.</p> <p>Design a dinner for their family to eat – think about choices and how they can make it balanced. Make sure you include the food types - eg stir fry - vitamins and minerals in vegetables, carbohydrates in noodles, chicken - protein. If able, make the dinner and receive feedback from family members – discuss this.</p>
Topic	<p><b>Crime &amp; Punishment</b>  - Learn key facts about our British Judicial system. Find out about the different types of courts.  <a href="https://kids.kiddle.co/English_law">https://kids.kiddle.co/English_law</a></p> <p>-Learn when state schools were officially banned from using corporal punishments and look at modern alternatives.</p>
PE	<p>Cosmic Yoga - brain busters  Joe Wicks - use 5 minute buster sessions - very important to keep fitness up.  Rugby - use a rolled up sock at home - play throw and catch, catch against a wall</p>

ART	<p>Look at the work of Natalie McIntyre - <a href="https://www.jacksonsart.com/blog/2016/04/27/natalie-mcintyre/">https://www.jacksonsart.com/blog/2016/04/27/natalie-mcintyre/</a></p> <p>Look carefully at how she draws and designs. On paper, draw using a pencil only, various beetles. Find different types of beetles from the internet. Copy them carefully and don't forget to add in all the little details!</p>
RE	<p>Vocation - Make up your own mission/vow which you are going to do, explain and write it down. What is your mission at this time in your life, how will you try to achieve it, what will you do? Look up the work of John Henry Newman - why is he famous, what did he do/achieve in his life? Produce a fact file on his life in any way you wish.</p> <p>Expectations - Read information about Mary's expectations- look up bible verses., Annunciation/Visitation – discuss how Mary would have felt, reacted. Write diary entry about bearing the Messiah – how you feel, emotions, expectations you have, faith that shapes your life. Discuss all ideas for how Mary would feel, how would Mary give more ideas, is it a burden, a responsibility?</p> <p>Write a prayer for yourself/your family/other people/volunteers etc. Decorate around this prayer.</p>
