Celebrating

Our topic in RE is Celebrating. How do you celebrate birthdays, Christmas and other special events? Try these activities together.

Prepare a tray with party items such as a party popper, balloon, parcel, card, party food etc. Play a game with the children – cover eyes, take away one or two items from the tray and ask what is missing.

Make a party hat for yourself and your teddies and have your own celebration.

Playdough Recipe

Ingredients

3 cups of flour

½ cup of salt

1 cup of hot water – from the tap (adults only)

2 tablespoons of oil

A splash of paint (we use children's paint from the art area) or some food colouring

What you need

A bowl

A small cup

A mixing spoon

What to do

1. Put the flour in the bowl

2. Add the salt

3. A grown up must carefully add the water

4. Add the paint or food colouring

5. Add the oil

6. Mix it all together until it forms the dough

7. Put the dough on the table

8. Knead the dough (squash and squeeze) until it is smooth – add more flour if it is still sticky

9. Have fun making!
