Wear Something Red Day to raise money for Comic Relief

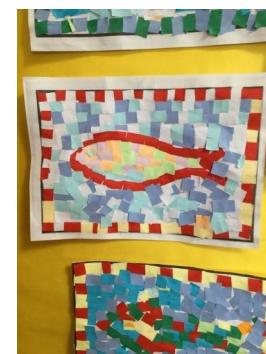
On Friday 19th

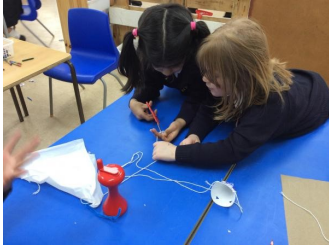
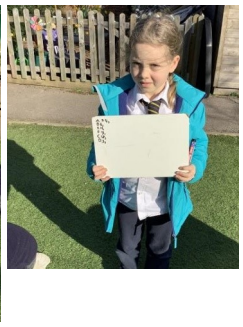

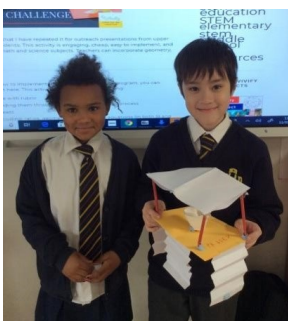
What have you discovered in Science Week?
