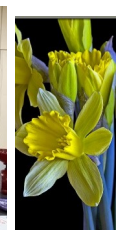

In Class 4G we had some fun this week painting traditional Roman shields. The children showed some great artistic talent and then made their own unique designs for their own Legions.



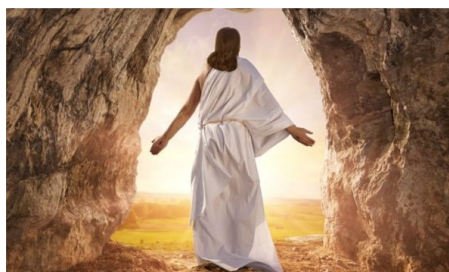

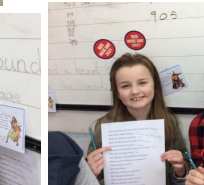
