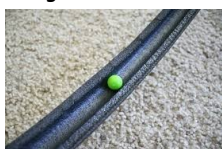
April Challenge

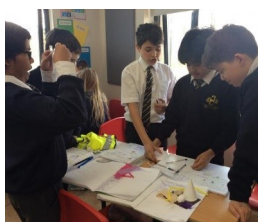
